ACADEMIC ENDORSEMENTS

Students enrolled in the Advanced Studies Academies are expected to attain an Academic Endorsement Diploma.

To qualify for an Academic Endorsement Diploma a graduate must meet or exceed the following criteria:

- * Successfully completed and passed all four components with a score of the GEE with a score of Basic
- * Achieve a TOPS Opportunity GPA
- * Obtain an ACT score of 23 or above

and one of the following:

- _____ Score a three (3) or higher on an Advanced Placement Test prior to their Senior year
- _____ Earned three (3) college hours of non-remedial articulated credit in core area (Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, Foreign Language, or English) by the end of the semester of the Senior year. **Students planning to enroll into Early Start courses during the summer must obtain prior approval from the principal.**
- _____ Enroll into and satisfactorily complete Senior Project.

“The senior shall engage in a personalized learning experience related to his or her area of concentration. Requirements include a score of satisfactory or higher on each of the following components: a research paper of 8-10 pages, a product which reflects 20 hours of related work-based learning and mentoring, portfolio that documents and reflects the Senior Projects process and a presentation to a panel of three to five adults from the community and school (Bulletin 741 LaDOE).”
